Who Can Participate?

We need children and adults of all ages with normal hearing, hearing loss and cochlear implants. Our researchers are enrolling individuals of all ages for studies throughout the year to help learn more about speech, language and hearing.



Where Do Studies Take Place?

Our hearing research programs are conducted at Boys Town National Research Hospital - Downtown Campus and the Lied Learning and Technology Center, located at 555 North 30th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

What are the Benefits?

In some cases, standard hearing, speech and language tests are provided to the participant at no cost. Monetary compensation is often provided.

How Do I Sign Up?

When Will I Be Contacted?

When your information matches the needs of a study, you will be contacted with a description of the study and given a choice to accept or decline the opportunity to participate.
